









RYABUSHINSKI.

GUNMALE, DECKBEAM AND RIB JOINTS

THIS KAYAK WAS PROBABLY COLLECTED BY JOCHELSON DURING HIS 1910 ARCHAEOLOGICAL EXPEDITION TO KAMCHATKA AND SENT TO THE PRIVATE MOSCOW MUSEUM OF HIS SPONSOR

THE CONSTRUCTION IS VERY CRUDE AND GIVEN MEASUREMENTS ARE NOMINAL AS INDIVIDUAL PIECES OF THE FRAME VARY GREATLY. A NUMBER OF RIBS ARE ATTACHED TO THE SIDE STRINGERS WITH WOODEN PEGS ABOUT 3MM. IN DIAMETER WHILE OTHERS ARE LASHED WITH SINEW. THE COAMING LASHING HOLES ARE ON APPROXIMATELY 5.9 CM, CENTERS. 3.1 CM. FROM THE TOP. THE COAMING AVERAGES 7 CM. IN HEIGHT, DECK BEAMS ARE MORTISED INTO THE CENTER OF THE GUNWALES THE SIDE DECK STRINGERS APPEAR TO BE SPLIT SAPLINGS. SOME DECK BEAMS ARE SQUARISH TIMBERS, SOME HALF-ROUND WITH A FLAT SECTION ON TOP WHILE MOST HAVE A RECTANGULAR CROSS SECTION WITH ROUNDED CORNERS, THE AFTERMOST DECK BEAM MEASURES 3.8 CM. WIDE BY 1.3 CM, THICK THE KEELSON IS 'V' SHAPED IN CROSS-SECTION FOR MOST OF IT'S LENGTH, BUT FLATTENS OUT IN THE ENDS WHERE IT IS JOINED WITH A PLAIN SCARE
